

Things to know if you want to come and live at Gannicox Camphill Community



Gannicox Camphill Community is a place where people with a learning disability can live and get support.

If you want to come and live here, there are some things you need to know about and things you should be prepared to do. We need to know that we can do the right things for you too.

1. **Doing things on your own or working towards doing things on your own** – you will get support to live here but we also want people to shape their life themselves as much as possible



2. **Giving you the support you need** - we try to be as fair as we can to everyone to keep you safe and make sure you get the chance to do new things

3. **Making sure there is enough money to give you the help and support you need** – we need to make sure there is enough money to pay for what you need while you are living at Gannicox



4. **Taking part in things** – at Gannicox we would like everyone to take part in some of the things we do together no matter what their age is or their ability.



5. **Helping to shape our community** – we would like the people who live at Gannicox to be involved in the running of the community. For example, you might want to take part by joining some meetings.

6. **Other people who already live here are happy for you to be here too**



7. **You should be at least 19 years old and you must have support needs to live at Gannicox**

8. **We are specially set up to support older people with learning disabilities** – we might need to keep some of our places at Gannicox for older people

9. **We cannot invite you to live at Gannicox if you tend to be a danger to yourself or you are not safe to be with other people** – we have to make sure the other people in our community are kept safe



10. **We cannot invite you live at Gannicox if you have a lot of mental health problems or problems with drugs or alcohol**



11. **We cannot give people help and support from a nurse or look after people day and night except during short-term illnesses**
